## Find the right place

Find a place where you can participate in your class.  
Have the necessary materials nearby, as well!



## Use your real name to enter Zoom

Your teacher needs to know who to let into the class.



## Raise your hand

Want to ask a question?  
Would you like to answer a question? Use the “Raise Hand” feature when you wish to talk!



## Unmute when needed

When you're not talking, keep your mic mute to reduce background noise. Unmute when you want to talk.

## Chat Away!

The Zoom chat is a great way to ask questions and to respond to your teacher's questions. It also allows you to participate if your mic isn't working.



## Breakout Room=Small Group

Breakout rooms are just like working with a small group or partner. Use the time to talk and work together.

## Use Google Classroom

## Make a Plan
